Monday October 25, 2004

The PCC had their monthly meeting on Tuesday October 12<sup>th</sup> after a summer hiatus. Their next meeting will be held on Tuesday November 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm. Many items were covered that were held over from earlier in the year and many new items brought. Below is a breakdown by area:

### **Liturgical:**

Planning of Advent Services, including Epiphany, with Pedro regarding Liturgical Server schedule. We will be trying something different regarding the schedules; in the places where no one has signed up, we will place people in those and let them find replacements. This is allow us to get an Advent mailing out.

We have put into place a Sunday morning worship greeter to welcome everyone and to handout St. Luke's literature.

Summer worship order: The committee evaluated and discussed the new suggested liturgy. Many points were brought up. It was the basic consensus that the music for the new order is good, whereas the substance of the order seemed to be a bit watered down.
